# Ni-Cd Batteries

- For environmental reasons, the European Union has already eliminated the use Ni-Cd (Nickel Cadmium) batteries as of the end of September 2010.
- Many manufacturers have already stopped production of Ni-Cd and are changing over to other technologies.
- As a result, Emhart will replace the Ni-Cd battery for a Li-Ion (Lithium-Ion) on the new MCS5800L Cordless Tool.



# Li-Ion Battery

- **Advantages vs. NiCd**
  - 45% lighter weight battery (0.8 lbs)
  - Higher energy per charge
  - No negative memory effect in case of partial charging
  - Increased number of charging cycles; higher life expectancy
  - Equal amount of setting rivets per charge
  - Re-designed base allows tool to stand upright





## Li-Ion Charger

- Li-Ion Batteries use a new charging technology
- Ni-Cd battery charger cannot be used to charge Li-Ion batteries
- Li-Ion battery charger cannot charge Ni-Cd batteries
- Buying a replacement Li-Ion battery will require buying a new replacement charger

- Tool includes:
  - Li-Ion Battery 14.4V
  - Battery Charger for Li-Ion 14.4V battery
  - Tool with 4 nosepieces and a wrench
  - Professional grade metal case

## FAQ's

- **Can I use the new Li-Ion Battery with the 'old' tool model?**
  - Yes, but you will need to order the new Li-Ion charger as well.
- **Can I use the old Ni-Cd Battery with the 'new' tool model?**
  - Yes, the body of the tool has not changed.
- **Can I use the old charger for the new Li-Ion battery?**
  - No; the new Li-Ion batteries use a different charging technology and are not compatible with the old charger. For the same reason, the Li-Ion charger won't charge Ni-Cd batteries. The Li-Ion battery will not fit the Ni-Cd charger and vice versa.
- **Would I be able to continue buying the Ni-Cd battery and charger?**
  - A few Ni-Cd chargers are still available; there are no old batteries available.
- **When will the new MCS5800L tool be available?**
  - Emhart will supply the new tool as soon as we deplete the inventory of the current model.
  - Spares of the Li-Ion battery and charger will be available in November.
